SUBJECT: CHARGES RE: AI 25-011

An investigation has been conducted by the Administrative Investigation Division, Professional Standards Bureau, of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. As a result of this investigation, the Administrative Review Board has determined that you committed the following violation.

On, but not limited to, July 24, 2025, while on duty in Pinellas County, Florida, you violated the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Act Laws of Florida, 89-404 as amended by Laws of Florida 08-285, Section 6, Subsection 4, by violating the provisions of law or the rules, regulations, and operating procedures of the Office of the Sheriff.

1. You violated Pinellas County Sheriff's Office General Order 3-1.3, Rule and Regulation 3.31(c), Inappropriate Conduct by Members of the Agency – Careless Handling of Firearms.


Synopsis: On July 24, 2025, you were working in the armory at the Sheriff's Administration Building (SAB). After cleaning your personally owned Glock handgun, you loaded and holstered the firearm. Shortly afterwards, you realized that you failed to reinstall two critical components. After removing the magazine and unholstering the firearm, you failed to properly eject the round from the chamber. As you continued to break down the firearm, you squeezed the trigger, unintentionally discharging the firearm.

You admitted to this violation.

Disciplinary Points and Recommended Discipline Range:

You were found to be in violation of one (1) Level Three Rule and Regulation violation totaling fifteen (15) points. These points, which were affected by no modified points from previous discipline, resulted in fifteen (15) progressive discipline points. At this point level, the recommended discipline range is from a Reprimand to a twenty-four (24) hour Suspension.

Disciplinary action shall be consistent with progressive discipline, for cause, in accordance with the provisions of the Pinellas County Civil Service Act.
