SUBJECT: CHARGES RE: AI-16-029

An investigation has been conducted by the Administrative Investigation Division, Professional Standards Bureau, of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. As a result of this investigation, the Administrative Review Board has determined you committed the following violations:

While on duty in Pinellas County, Florida, you violated the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Act Laws of Florida, 89-404 as amended by Laws of Florida 08-285, Section 6, Subsection 4, by violating the provisions of law or the rules, regulations, and operating procedures of the Office of the Sheriff.

1. You violated Pinellas County Sheriff's Office General Order 3-1.1, Rule and Regulation 5.4, Duties and Responsibilities.

Synopsis: While assigned to the Department of Detention and Corrections, it was determined, based on evidence and testimony, that you neglected your assigned duties and responsibilities.

You acknowledged that while on duty, you condoned, participated in, or recorded, via photograph or video, multiple incidents of unauthorized activity involving a total of, including yourself, nine (9) Pinellas County Sheriff's Office members, assigned to the Department of Detention and Corrections.

This prohibited activity was recreational and included games, idling, loafing, sleeping, wrestling, use of cellular phones and televisions. This activity was, through witness testimony, defined as "horseplay" and "joking." All unauthorized activity occurred within the Pinellas County Jail during members assigned work hours. All unauthorized incidents were captured via your cellular phone.

While engaged in this activity, which occurred on numerous occasions, through an extended period of time, Pinellas County Sheriff's Office duties and responsibilities were neglected.

You admitted to this violation.

3. You violated Pinellas County Sheriff's Office General Order 3-1.3, Rule and Regulation 3.31(g), Inappropriate Conduct by Members of the Agency.

Synopsis: While a supervisor, assigned to the Department of Detention and Corrections, you failed to properly supervise, or take appropriate action to cease improper and unauthorized activities committed by subordinates, in your presence. In all incidents you either condoned, or participated by capturing the prohibited activity via photograph, or video recording. You testified that at no time were efforts made to fulfill your duties and responsibilities, as a supervisor, to prevent this unauthorized conduct.

You admitted to this violation.

Disciplinary Points and Recommended Discipline Range:

You were found to be in violation of one (1) Level 5 Rule/Regulation and one (1) Level 3 Rule/Regulation, totaling sixty five (65) points. These points, combined with thirteen (13) carryover points from previous discipline, resulted in seventy eight (78) progressive discipline points. In accordance with agency policy, this point total reverts to seventy five (75) and recommended discipline ranges are from (10) days suspension to termination.

Disciplinary action shall be consistent with progressive discipline, for cause in accordance with the provisions of the Pinellas County Civil Service Act.
