SUBJECT: CHARGES RE: AI-16-027

An investigation has been conducted by the Administrative Investigation Division, Professional Standards Bureau, of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. As a result of this investigation, the Administrative Review Board has determined you committed the following violation:

On October 16, 2016, while on duty in Pinellas County, Florida, you violated the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Act Laws of Florida, 89-404 as amended by Laws of Florida 08-285, Section 6, Subsection 4, by violating the provisions of law or the rules, regulations, and operating procedures of the Office of the Sheriff.

1. You violated Pinellas County Sheriff's Office General Order 3-1.1, Rule and Regulation 5.4, Duties and Responsibilities.

Synopsis: While assigned to Inmate Records as a Shift Supervisor, you were responsible for receiving, reviewing and approving documentation concerning the custody status of inmates.

On October 16, 2016, during the review of an inmates file, you failed to recognize that the inmate was court ordered to remain in custody. You authorized the inmate's release from the Pinellas County Jail, and your error resulted in the erroneous release of the inmate.

You admitted to this violation.

Disciplinary Points and Recommended Discipline Range:

You were found to have violated one (1) Level Five Rule/Regulation, totaling fifty (50) points. This point total, with no modified points from previous discipline, resulted in fifty (50) progressive discipline points. In accordance with agency policy, this point total remains at fifty (50) and recommended discipline is five (5) days suspension to termination.

Disciplinary action shall be consistent with progressive discipline, for cause in accordance with the provisions of the Pinellas County Civil Service Act.
